**Permission — to fly Civil Air Ensign**

**1 Duration**

The instrument:

- (a) commences on 1 May 2011; and
- (b) stops having effect at the end of April 2013.

**2 Application**

The instrument applies to the flying or the display of the Civil Air Ensign (the *Ensign*) by the Australian Air League Incorporated, Aviation Reference Number 401912 (the *Air League*).

**3 Permission**

I give permission to the Air League to fly or display the Ensign at any of the events mentioned in Schedule 1.

**4 Conditions**

The permission is subject to the conditions mentioned in Schedule 2.

**Schedule 1 Events**

- 1 ANZAC Day commemorations and services.
- 2 Remembrance Day commemorations and services.
- 3 Aviation related community commemorations and services.
- 4 Australian Air League, New South Wales Group Ceremonial Parade.
- 5 Australian Air League, New South Wales Group Review and Parades.

- 6 Australian Air League, Victoria Group Review and Parades.
- 7 Australian Air League, Queensland Group Review and Parades.
- 8 Australian Air League, South Australia Wing Parades.
- 9 Australian Air League, Western Australia Wing Parades.
- 10 Australian Air League (National) Review and Parades.
- 11 Other Australian Air League Reviews, Parades and events that occur from time to time.

## **Schedule 2      Conditions**

- 1 The Ensign must not be flown or displayed at any airport, aerodrome or airfield.
  - 2 If the Ensign is flown or displayed with other flags, it must be flown or displayed in accordance with the Australian Order of Precedence for flying of flags.
  - 3 The Ensign must be in the custody of Michael Hodge or his delegate when not in use.
