STANDARD NAME BADGE

1.0 Background

- 1.1 Federal Administration Instruction No. 79/2016 F/AI/79/16 dated 29 February 2016 is superseded by this Instruction
- 1.2 The Council of the Air League has approved the introduction and wearing of a standard name badge for all Officers and Associate members
- 1.3 The introduction of standard name badges has many advantages; in particular, a name badge will:
 - 1.3.1 Look professional and demonstrate national identity.
 - 1.3.2 Build the AAL brand and create a positive image for our organisation.
 - 1.3.3 Assist with communications.
 - 1.3.4 Assist with personal identification and security considerations.
 - 1.3.5 Reflect a style similar to the RAAF and similar uniformed organisations.
 - 1.3.6 Build unit morale and personal recognition.

2.0 Design

- 2.1 Two designs had been developed and colours have been matched to reflect the Officer uniform royal blue and have now been matched to the new navy blue.
- 2.2 The content of each badge is deliberately kept simple and was determined after detailed discussions.
- 2.3 The navy blue background is for uniformed Officers and white background for Associate members.



2.4 Other considerations are as follow:

- 2.4.1 The badge is an **optional purchase** and not a compulsory uniform item; however, when worn on uniform must be placed in the prescribed position.
- 2.4.2 For Officers, the badge can be worn on the uniform, but only above the right breast pocket centrally above any medal ribbons.
- 2.4.3 The Officer badge can also be worn with civilian clothes.
- 2.4.2 Badge size is 75mm x 25mm with AAL logo.
- 2.4.3 Font used is Tahoma (AAL standard).
- 2.4.4 Badges are retained with a strong magnetic device; a non-magnetic pin fastener is available on special request.
- 2.4.5 Alternative name badge designs are not permitted on the AAL uniform.
- 2.4.6 Officers with more than one position should select the most senior role.
- 2.4.7 Officers may purchase more than one badge (one per role).

3.0 Supply

- 3.1 Badges must be ordered from Federal using the attached *Name Badge - Order Form*.
- 3.2 A minimum order is 10 name badges. Orders received below this number will be held until additional orders are received to allow the order to be placed
- 3.3 The cost per badge, including postage, is \$15.00 (August 2022).
- 3.4 Delivery is approximately 21 days.

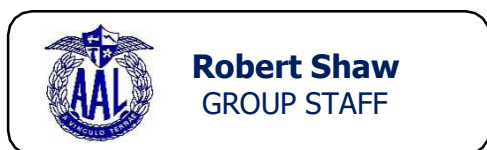

- Badge size is 75mm x 25mm with AAL logo; Tahoma font
- Approved Officer Badge: **BLUE** background and **WHITE** lettering (reverse to colours shown below)
- Approved Associate Badge: **WHITE** background and **BLUE** lettering (as shown below)
- The cost per badge is **\$15.00** (Including postage and packaging)
- Preferably ONE order per squadron, and ONE per Group for staff officers
 - **NOTE: A minimum order is 10 name badges. Orders received below this number will be held until additional orders are received to allow the order to be placed**
- Badges are retained with a strong magnetic fastener
 - **For those with health issues the badge can be supplied with a non-magnetic pin fastener and this should be clearly notated on order form**
- Group or Wing Staff Officer badges should include **Name** and **Group Staff** or **Wing Staff**
- Squadron Office/Associate badges should include **Name** and **Squadron** location (i.e. Gold Coast)
- Delivery is approximately 21 days from receipt of order.
