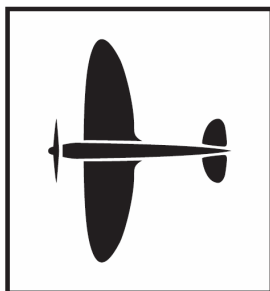
2.0 The following changes have been made to the manual and are advised for the information of all Units and personnel

2.1 The Bugler badge appearing on PLATE 2 (1) has been changed to

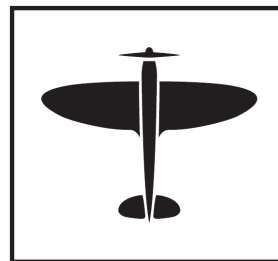

2.2 The Aircraft Modelling Plastic badge shown in PLATE 2 (1) as

The badge will be worn on the shirt sleeve as now shown.

2.2 Section 16

2.2.1 Paragraph 10.3.4 shall have the following wording removed as there is no theory examination for this badge

EXAMINATION - All models submitted must meet an acceptable standard. Together with the models, a multiple choice theory examination is required, covering

The correct use of Tools.

Covering materials and correct application.

Materials and part identification.

Engines, correct use and safety procedures.

Safety rules, flying field etiquette and Insurance.

The theory examination shall cover 20% of the overall marks for the course.

2.2.5.1 Paragraph 10.7.4 shall have the following wording added

2.3 Section 17

2.3.1 Paragraph 21.1 should read

21.0 **Cadet of the Year Award**

21.1 Winners of the Federal, and Group, Cadet of the Year Awards are allowed to wear the badge described in para 21.2.

21.2.1 The badge shall be a plain bar, in gold for the Federal award, or silver for the Group award, engraved "Cadet of the Year 20??." and shall be worn in the centre of the flap of the right breast pocket.

NB The change is to remove the words "above the right breast pocket of the uniform." And insert the words "centre of the flap of the right breast pocket"

2.4 Section 18

2.4.1 Paragraph 1.13 is now to read

1.13 Dress rings, ear rings (female members only may, for pierced ears, wear plain sleeper or Stud type earrings of Silver or Gold with only one per ear worn in the lobe of the ears), bangles and necklaces are NOT to be worn with the uniform.

NB The change is to add the words "worn in the lobe of the ears." This was the original intent of the paragraph.

2.4.2 Paragraphs 1.20.1 to 1.20.3 are now to read

1.20 Australian Air League Inc. Insignia/Awards

1.20.1 Australian Air League Inc. insignia must only be worn on Air League uniform. This does not apply to the Australian Air League Inc. Membership Badge (tie pin) or the Australian Air League Inc. Life Membership badge or miniature medals

1.20.2 Only decorations, awards and badges specified in the Australian Air League Inc. Manual, or specifically approved by the Council of the Australian Air League Inc. as required by Section 17 of this Manual, may be worn on Australian Air League uniforms.

1.20.3 Miniature service medals may be worn on civilian dress whilst miniature service brevets may only be worn on the Mess jacket.



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
