Education Feedback and Workbook Listing

1.0 Preamble

- 1.1 To assist Squadrons with common queries regarding education within the Australian Air League, several resources have been added to the Air League website for Officers and cadets to access.

2.0 Education Feedback Form

- 2.1 To allow members to report issues discovered in workbooks and assessments, a feedback form has been established on the Air League website to provide members the ability to report errors they have found or to give general feedback.
- 2.2 By reporting the errors this should allow a quicker turn around for the correction of any errors. This will help in reporting any changes back to the relevant Group staff.
- 2.3 This form can also be used for Field and Air Activities workbooks and assessments.

- 2.5 Please note that some workbooks may reference aircraft operated at the time of publication, for example **General Proficiency 3** deals with aircraft operated by the **Australian Defence Forces** as at 2011. This information will change over time, and these workbooks will be reviewed and amended to reflect this. Whilst updates will not be published for every change, we invite feedback to be included in future revisions when the book is updated.

3.0 Workbook Listing

- 3.1 The purpose of the workbook listing is to provide Squadrons the ability to identify the current workbook for each badge and to identify the proposed badges and workbooks that are currently being written.
- 3.2 Squadrons are encouraged to check they are using the current workbooks to ensure their cadets are studying the latest information and have the best chance of passing their assessments.
