Pre-Requisites for Education Syllabus

1.0 Background

- 1.1 It has become evident that a number of squadrons are not following the set pre-requisite for the education syllabus and have been skipping the required badges.

2.0 Preamble

- 2.1 The purpose of this instruction is to outline the requirements for education badge syllabus and instruction.
- 2.2 Please refer to the 'Attachment A' chart included with this instruction as a guide to the education pre-requisites.

3.0 Badges Prerequisites

- 3.1 All Education badges except GP6 have a pre-requisite. This has been in place for a number of years and all pre-requisite badges are stated in the AAL Manual.
- 3.2 As a part of the Education syllabus **ALL** members are required to follow the Education Pre-requisites prior to moving onto other badges, as per the AAL Manual.

3.2.1 *Section 16. Paragraph 5.*

- 5.5. *All badges must be taken in sequence despite a member's age. For example, a member, whether a Junior Cadet, Cadet, Senior Cadet, Trainee Officer, or Officer, will be required to pass General Proficiency Class 6 (Junior Cadets) or General Proficiency Class 6 & 5 (all other members), before proceeding on to any other subject. The same will be required for all badges. Skipping badges is not permitted and will be enforced by Wing, Region and Group Education Staff.*
- Only in special circumstances will a member be permitted to skip badges, (Refer to **Paragraph 5.6** below and Paragraph 2.7).*
- 5.6. *No badge may be skipped unless in there is a case of Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) where a member qualifies for a badge where he/she has sat an examination/course from an outside provider, for example CASA BAK.*

- 3.3 Effective ***immediately*** all members must complete any and all Education Pre-requisite badges required for badges currently held, prior to moving onto other workbooks.
- 3.4 If a member has skipped badges and moved onto other core subjects it is requested that the GEC instruct these squadrons to complete the required badges as a high priority and prior to completion of any further badges.

4.0 Effective

- 4.1 This instruction is effective as of 1st March 2020, and will remain in force until cancelled or replaced.
