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Space Flight 4

1.0 Preamble

- 1.1 The new Space Flight 4 (SF4) workbook is now complete and available for purchase online at <https://www.airleague.com.au/gmstore> (search for Space Flight 4).
- 1.2 This Instruction is to inform all members of the content and assessment procedures.

2.0 General information

- 2.1 The new SF4 is a totally new course and badge (pictured). It is a Junior Subject and covers the various subjects pertaining to Space Flight.
- 2.2 This course is intended as an introduction to the topic of Space Flight and is aimed at the 8 to 11-year age group.



3.0 Assessment procedures

- 3.1 Members sitting this course must have first completed GP6 and for members 12 years and over GP6 and GP5.
- 3.2 The pass mark for this course is 60%.
- 3.3 There are workbook questionnaires throughout the workbook to help ensure that a member understands the content.
- 3.4 As per normal, the workbook questionnaires form part of the overall marks and must be completed and marked prior to a request for the Knowledge Assessment. They are not optional.
- 3.5 Members not completing these questionnaires will have their Form 28 returned until such a time as they are completed. GEC's/REO's will have the right to ask to see member's workbooks to ensure that the questionnaires are being completed.
- 3.6 Knowledge Assessments are written to cater for both age groups. These will be a combination of picture recognition, multiple choice and short written answers.

4.0 SF4 Badge – (Green Rocket)

- 4.1 The Space Flight 4 badge will be a Green Rocket.
