Australian Air League Review Sunday, 30 September 2018

1.0 Intention

- 1.1 This circular provides preliminary information for the 2018 Australian Air League Review.

2.0 Date and Location

- 2.1 The Australian Air League Review will be held on Sunday, 30 September 2018. The location is scheduled to be Sydney, New South Wales. Units will be advised of the actual venue as soon as this is finalised.
- 2.2 Members should note that the Review will be held on a Sunday, not Saturday as per recent AAL Reviews.

3.0 Field Competitions

- 3.1 Field Competition Diagrams will be **Diagram No 8**.
- 3.2 Competitions will be held in the following categories:
- 3.2.1 Squadron Section Drill
 - 3.2.2 Junior Section Drill
 - 3.2.3 Wing Section Drill
 - 3.2.4 Officer Section Drill (open to Groups only)
 - 3.2.5 Flag Party Drill
 - 3.2.6 Flight Drill
 - 3.2.7 Band Drill
- 3.3 With the exception of Squadron Section Drill, where units do not have sufficient numbers to compete in their own right, units may combine from the same State/Group to compete. Full eligibility details will be provided in the 2018 Australian Air League Review Digest to be issued in due course.

4.0 Band and Solo Music Competitions

- 4.1 The compulsory tune for music competitions and band drill is Tune No 21 – **Bugle March 4**, as per [Australian Air League Manual Section 20, Paragraph 51.12](#).
- 4.2 Solo music competitions will be held for Snare Drum, Tenor Drum and Bugle in the following age categories:
- 4.2.1 8 – 11 years
- 4.2.2 12 – 15 years
- 4.2.3 16 – 17 years
- 4.2.4 18 years and over.

5.0 Ball Games

- 5.1 Ball Games for the 2018 Australian Air League Review are:
- 5.1.1 First Game **Game No. 1** Tunnel Ball (medicine ball)
- 5.1.2 Second Game **Game No. 2** Run and Throw Back Relay (basketball)
- 5.1.3 Third Game **Game No. 3** Bounce Relay (basketball)
- 5.2 Separate competitions will be held for male and female.
- 5.3 Only one entry per State/Group per gender category will be allowed.

6.0 2020 Australian Air League Review
