Australian Air League Review Sunday 23 September 2018

1.0 Intention

1.1 This circular provides general information on Field Activities at the 2018 Australian Air League Review.

2.0 Date and Venue

2.1 The Australian Air League Review will be held on Sunday, 23 September 2018 at Crest Athletics Track, McLean St, Georges Hall (Sydney) NSW. New South Wales members should note that this is the same venue as for the New South Wales Boys and Girls Reviews. Please see section 8.0 for details of location of venue.

3.0 Field Competitions

- 3.1 Field Competition Diagrams will be Diagram No 8.
- 3.2 Competitions will be held in the following categories (See links for diagrams):
- 3.2.1 Squadron Section Drill
- 3.2.2 Junior Section Drill
- 3.2.3 Wing Section Drill
- 3.2.4 Officer Section Drill (open to Groups only)
- 3.2.5 Flag Party Drill
- 3.2.6 Flight Drill
- 3.2.7 Band Drill
- 3.3 Squadrons can combine in most competitions where they do not have enough numbers to compete in their own right. The only competition where squadrons cannot combine is Squadron Section Drill. Squadrons who need to combine with other squadrons compete in Wing Section Drill.

4.0 Competition Categories

- 4.1 There are two categories of competitions:
- 4.1.1 Open Competition
- 4.1.2 Boys Only Competition
- 4.2 All squadrons may take part in the Open Competition.
- 4.3 Boys Squadrons and those with a sufficient number of males may take part in the Boys Only Competition.
- 4.4 A squadron partaking in one competition cannot take part in the other.

5.0 Band and Solo Music Competitions

- 5.1 The compulsory tune for music competitions and band drill is Tune No 21 **Bugle March 4**, as per Australian Air League Manual Section 20, Paragraph 51.12.
- 5.2 Solo music competitions will be held for Snare Drum, Tenor Drum and Bugle in the following age categories:
- 5.2.1 8 11 years
- 5.2.2 12 15 years
- 5.2.3 16 17 years
- 5.2.4 18 years and over
- 5.3 Separate competitions will be held for male and female.


6.0 Ball Games

- 6.1 Ball Games for the 2018 Australian Air League Review are:
- 6.1.1 First Game No. 1 Tunnel Ball (medicine ball)
- 6.1.2 Second Game **Game No. 2** Run and Throw Back Relay (basketball)
- 6.1.3 Third Game **Game No. 3** Bounce Relay (basketball)
- 6.2 Separate competitions will be held for male and female.
- 6.3 Only one entry per State/Group per gender category will be allowed.
