Australian Air League Review

Saturday, 3 October 2020

1.0 Intention

- 1.1 This circular provides preliminary information for the 2020 Australian Air League Review.

2.0 Date

- 2.1 The Australian Air League Review will be held on Saturday, 3 October 2020.

3.0 Location

- 3.1 The Review will be held at the Sports Super Centre at Runaway Bay, Gold Coast Queensland. (same location as 2011 AAL Review).

4.0 Field Competitions

- 4.1 Field Competition Diagrams will be **Diagram No 10**.
- 4.2 Competitions will be held in the following categories:
- 4.2.1 Squadron Section Drill
 - 4.2.2 Junior Section Drill
 - 4.2.3 Wing Section Drill
 - 4.2.4 Officer Section Drill (open to Groups only)
 - 4.2.5 Flag Party Drill
 - 4.2.6 Flight Drill. Please note that Flight Diagram No 10 was changed as per Federal Field Instruction No 55. Updated details can be found in the Australian Air League Manual at Flight Competition Diagrams.
 - 4.2.7 Band Drill
- 4.3 With the exception of Squadron Section Drill, where units do not have sufficient numbers to compete in their own right, units may combine from the same State/Group to compete. Full eligibility details will be provided in the 2020 Australian Air League Review Digest to be issued in due course.

5.0 Band and Solo Music Competitions

- 5.1 The compulsory tune for music competitions and band drill is Tune No 20 – Maynards Fancy as per Australian Air League Manual Section 20, Paragraph 51.14.
- 5.2 Solo music competitions will be held for Snare Drum, Tenor Drum and Bugle in the following age categories:
- 5.2.1 8 – 11 years
- 5.2.2 12 – 15 years
- 5.2.3 16 – 17 years
- 5.2.4 18 years and over.

6.0 Ball Games

- 6.1 Ball Games for the 2018 Australian Air League Review are:
- 6.1.1 First Game **Game No. 1** Tunnel Ball (medicine ball)
- 6.1.2 Second Game **Game No. 4** Bounce Return Relay (basketball)
- 6.1.3 Third Game **Game No. 5** Time Ball Relay (basketball)
- 6.2 Separate competitions will be held for male and female.
- 6.3 Only one entry per State/Group per gender category will be allowed.
