2.0 Application for Adult League Membership (Form 10)

- 2.1 As previously advised, a new membership application form (Form 10) has been introduced which must be used in all the following situations:
 - 2.1.1 New applications for adult League membership (uniformed membership) for all persons of eighteen years of age, or older.
 - 2.1.2 Applications for adult League membership for former Cadets who have reached eighteen years of age and who wish to apply to continue their membership as an adult member; and
 - 2.1.3 Associate members applying to transfer to adult League membership.
- 2.2 The Form 10 must be completed in full at all stages of the application process and must be physically (not electronically) signed by both the applicant and the Group Executive Commissioner.
 - 2.2.1 An applicant's membership will not be confirmed until ALL information and verifications have been completed at which time the Group Executive Commissioner is able to sign the Form.
- 2.3 Use of Form 10 is mandatory for all adult member applications from 8th August 2023.
- 2.4 Attention is directed to the AAL Manual at Section 8 *Squadron Administration*,
 Paragraph 18 *Procedures for the Enrolment of Members*, which has been amended to align the AAL Manual more closely with the AAL Constitution in this area.
- 2.5 This Form is **NOT** to be loaded into the NAS without the signature of the relevant Group Executive Commissioner.

3.0 Mandatory Child Safety Training

- 3.1 Initial roll out of Mandatory Child Safety Training is occurring across the League.
- 3.2 The roll out has been completed in Queensland, South Australia and Victoria with the NSW roll out planned for late January 2024.


