11.0 <u>Officers Cap Buttons</u>
11.1 Officers are reminded that only approved Australian Air League buttons as detailed in the AAL Manual Section 18 are to be worn on the male Officer cap.

12.0 Warrant Officers

Members are reminded that Warrant Officers are required to wear a navy blue lanyard as part of their AAL Uniform , which is the same as worn by NCO'S.

The navy blue lanyard is to be worn by Warrant Officers on their shirt and tunic as appropriate.

The AAL Manual describes the wearing and positioning for Warrant Officers of their lanyard at Section 7- Paragraph 3.2, as follows;

"Warrant Officer shall wear a navy blue lanyard, 13mm in width, at the extremity of the left shoulder, under the shoulder strap with the long end of the lanyard retained short in the left breast pocket."

13.0 Officer Warrants

- 13.1 Any Officer holidng the rank of Second Officer or higher MUST have bene issued with an Officer Warrant
- 13.2 The Australian Air League Inc. manual at Section 6 states:

4.0 WARRANTS.

- 4.1 All Officers of the League shall be issued with an Officer's Warrant under the Common Seal of the League. The prospective Officer must sign a Charge for Presentation of Warrant (Form 14) as to the responsibilities accepted.
- 4.2 Following the approval of the appointment to Officer Rank by the Group Council, the Group Executive Commissioner shall forward to the Federal Administration Commissioner, within thirty (30) days, the signed Charge for Presentation of Warrant as well as the duplicate Application for an Officer Warrant (Form 41).
- 13.3 Any Officer holding the rank of Second Officer or higher who has NOT been presented with their Officer Warrant is required to advise their Group Executive Commisioner and also email the following details to <u>info@airleague.com.au</u> so that this matter may be rectified. The details required to be emailed are: Full name

Date of Joining

Date of promotion to 2nd Officer rank (if known)

13.4 <u>The issue of an Office Warrant is an important part of our structure and the legal</u> responsibilities of the League and an Officer.

14.2 Assistant to Chief Commissioner – Marketing
