

FEDERAL TRAINING CIRCULAR No 1 OF 2019

Training on Pathway Choices

For Members approaching Eighteen years of age

- 1.0 An online course is to be developed which will be required to be undertaken by all cadets prior to reaching the age of eighteen years.
- 2.0 This course will advise each cadet member of, for example, their:
 - 2.1 Choices regarding remaining in the League, including becoming:
 - 2.1.1 A Warrant Officer with the view to obtaining an Officer Warrant after successfully completing the Officer Development Program;
 - 2.1.2 A Warrant Officer with the view to "marking time" by staying in uniform and helping out their local Squadron on a regular basis, whilst they address their major focus on such other important issues as their final year of High School or University studies;
 - 2.1.3 An Associate Member and assisting in their local Branch; or
 - 2.1.4 An Adult Supporter and assisting their local Squadron on an intermittent basis.
 - 2.2 The steps required to achieve each of the choices outlined.
 - 2.3 Obligations as an adult member of the League or Adult Supporter, regardless of their chosen direction, including:
 - 2.3.1 Applying for, and obtaining, a valid Working with Children Check.
- 3.0 Armed with the information provided to them in this course, they will be enabled to take their immediate career path into their own hands and, with appropriate mentoring as required, achieve their medium-term aims within the League.
- 4.0 A document version of this course is planned to be loaded on the Resource Page of the website during October 2019.
- 5.0 An interactive online version is planned to be implemented by 31 December 2019.
- 6.0 Further particulars will be publicised via the website and Training Instruction, as each stage is ready to be launched.
