Advance in Review Order

1.0 Intention

- 1.1 The intention of this Instruction is to amend AAL Manual at Section 10, paragraph 36.0 related to the performance of drill movements for 'Advance in Review Order'.
- 1.2 The purpose of this amendment is to bring the performance of an 'Advance in Review Order' in conformity with the accepted historical practice of carrying out this manoeuvre.

2.0 General

- 2.1 The AAL Manual at Section 10 paragraph 36 is amended in the following terms:
 - 36.2 Parade Formation
 - 36.2.1 The Parade will form up in accordance with the Parade formation as set out in the diagram at the end of this Instruction.
 - 36.3. Movement
 - 36.3.1. Once the Parade has been formed in accordance with the illustration, the Parade Commanding Officer will give the order "ParadeOpen Order.....March". All Units on Parade including the Band (which is positioned centre rear of the Parade) will perform an open order march position.
 - 36.3.2. The Parade Commanding Officer, about turns to face the Parade and gives the order "ParadeInwards Dress".

Units with the principal flag on their left, perform a left dress.

Units with the principal flag on their right perform a right dress.

The inwards dress should be performed quickly and does not involve individual NCO's or Officers to dress their units.

- 36.3.3. When the Parade Commanding Officer is satisfied that members have stopped moving, the Parade Commanding Officer will order "Parade Eyes Front".
- 36.6.4. The Parade Commanding Officer about turns to face the saluting dais and orders "Parade, will Advance in Review Order Parade, By the Centre Quick." At this point, the band will perform 2 three beat introductory rolls with the Parade stepping off on the seventh beat of the bass drum. The Parade marches for fifteen paces and halts. The Parade steps off with the left foot, this being the first pace. The fifteenth pace is concluded as the left foot strikes the ground and the right foot is brought immediately to the position of attention.

- 36.3.5. At the conclusion of the fifteen paces, the Parade Commanding Officer orders "Parade General Salute". . All Officers salute and Air League (Unit) flags are dipped. Once the band has finished, all Officers will return to the attention position and Air League (Unit) flags will be raised back to the carry position
- 36.3.6. The Parade Commanding Officer about turns to face the Parade and gives the order to inwards dress. The Parade carries out the same procedures as set out in paragraph 36.3.2. The Parade Commanding Officer then orders the Parade to eyes front in the same manner as set out in paragraph 36.3.3.
- 36.3.7. The Parade Commanding Officer orders, "Parade, Stand At Ease". The Parade Commanding Officer about turns to face the saluting dais and stands at ease. This completes the Advance in Review Order procedure.

3.0 Conclusion

3.1 The provisions of this Instruction have immediate effect.
