AIR ACTIVITIES FINAL PARADE 2012 CHRISTMAS PICNIC AFTERNOON

1.0 Intention

- 1.1 New South Wales Boys' Group and the Air Activities Centre extend an invitation to your unit to attend our 2012 final parade, fun and picnic day, this event be hosted on a **Sunday 25th November 2012**.
- 1.2 The day will consist of a parade, with competitions on the march, joy flights in the local area, games, and fun.

2.0 Air Activities

- 2.1 Powered Flying
- 2.1.1 Joy Flights will be conducted all day at a cost of \$50.00 a head, this covers an approx 30 minute flight over Camden, The Oaks, and Warragamba.
- 2.1.2 Due to limits on daylight, pilots, and aircraft availability, squadrons must notify Air Activities which members from their squadron will be wishing to fly on this day. To avoid disappointment I would urge you to get these requests in fast, email to flying.nsw@airleague.com.au. Flying is to commence at 0730hrs.
- 2.1.3 Any member wishing to take part in flying training on this day, or do a TIF will need to have this pre-arranged as per usual booking process, contact Air Activities Staff.

2.2 Gliding and Soaring

- 2.2.1 This year we will also be offering members the opportunity to have their go at gliding with Sydney Gliding.
- 2.2.2 There is very limited space available for members to take part in gliding, be sure to get your expression of interest in fast. All enquiries regarding gliding are to be directed to the O.C. Gliding, Squadron Lieutenant Malcolm Fraser malcolm.fraser@optusnet.com.au.
- 2.2.3 The cost for a 20-25 minute Flight in a state of the art powered glider will be \$130.00.
- 2.3 All enquiries for Air Activities are to be submitted by Friday 16th November 2012.

- 3.2 The parade will be assembled at 1045hrs near Camden Airport's Control Tower. The parade will then be marched around Airport Road commencing at 1100hrs, a General Salute Eyes Right will be given as the parade is marched onto and reassembled on the grassed area next to the Air Activities Centre.

- 3.4 Competitions on the March; trophies will be awarded for:
 - 3.4.1 Best Boys / Girls Flag Party
 - 3.4.2 Best Boys / Girls Squadron
- 3.5 Prior to the parade units with bands are invited to compete for a third award *Best Band*; at 1000hrs the O.C. Parade will call for the first band entry to perform a free choice piece, there will be no limits or requirements to this performance other than it to be contained within a 5-7 minute timeframe.
- 3.6 Once the bands have completed their performances and under the direction of the Group Band Officer they will form a Massed Group Band, this band will lead the parade. There will be no band competition on the march.

4.0 Afternoon Activity

- 4.1 Once the formalities of the day are finalized the games will begin, under the direction of the Group Physical Activities Commissioner there will be, Ball Games, Tug-O-War events, and Relay Races.
 - 4.1.1 No Formal Awards will be presented for these games.
- 4.2 We are also hoping that members of the Air League have been good enough this year to deserve a visit from Santa. We will have to wait until the day to find out.
- 4.3 Make sure that your squadrons and families bring everything you need to make the most of your time out in the sun and have a great picnic.
